## CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play that every candidate and political committee in this state has a moral obligation to observe and uphold, in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, our citizens may exercise their constitutional rights to a free and untrammelled choice and the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

### THEREFORE:

- (1) I will conduct the campaign openly and publicly and limit attacks on my opponent to legitimate challenges to my opponent's record and stated positions on issues.
- (2) I will not use or permit the use of character defamation, whispering campaigns, libel, slander, or scurrilous attacks on any candidate or the candidate's personal or family life.
- (3) I will not use or permit any appeal to negative prejudice based on race, sex, religion, or national origin.
- (4) I will not use campaign material of any sort that misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise falsifies the facts, nor will I use malicious or unfounded accusations that aim at creating or exploiting doubts, without justification, as to the personal integrity or patriotism of my opponent.
- (5) I will not undertake or condone any dishonest or unethical practice that tends to corrupt or undermine our system of free elections or that hampers or prevents the full and free expression of the will of the voters, including any activity aimed at intimidating voters or discouraging them from voting.
- (6) I will defend and uphold the right of every qualified voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process, and will not engage in any activity aimed at intimidating voters or discouraging them from voting.
- (7) I will immediately and publicly repudiate methods and tactics that may come from others that I have pledged not to use or condone. I shall take firm action against any subordinate who violates any provision of this code or the laws governing elections.

I, the undersigned, candidate for election to public office in the State of Texas or campaign treasurer of a political committee, hereby voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct the campaign in accordance with the above principles and practices.

## Biography of Bob Brown

I was born to Jeff & Sue Brown on Dec. 24, 1944 in Snyder, Texas. My dad was flying B-24's in WWII over Italy at the time I was born. I went to grade school in Snyder until the 5th grade, and then we moved to Big Spring, Texas where I finished the rest of my schooling and graduated from Big Spring High School in 1963. I joined the Navy in Feb 1964 and went to Hospital Corps School in San Diego after Boot Camp and became a Hospital Corpsman. I was sent to Oakland Naval Hospital for additional training and then when the Vietnam war broke out, and I spent the rest of my career on the ground as a Navy Corpsman and eventually aboard ship which was also in and out of Vietnam from Nov. 1965 to Jan 1968. I was Honorably discharged in January 1968.

I started going to a Junior College and Majored in Computer Science and Minored in Accounting. They had a two year program in Computer Science upon completion they would guarantee you a job at a major company. I finished the two year program and went to work at the Department of Veterans Affairs Data Processing Center in Austin, Texas. I first started in the Computer room a computer operator for the first 4 years and then I became a Computer Programmer taking their classes at their facility. I was programmer for 3 years, then I became a System Auditor auditing the programs that were written by the Programmers for the users in the field. After three years I was asked by the Director of the Data Processing Center to move to one of the offices of the Director, to work on a Mainframe (Large Computer for the Computer Center) Replacement for the Center. I worked on two different Main Frame Replacements over a 10 year period assisting in creating the RFPs (Request for Proposals) and evaluating vendors bids on the equipment they submitted to the Dept of Veterans Affairs for the bids at the Austin Data Processing Center. These RFP's were created in Austin and we evaluated them in Washington D.C. at the Dept. of Veterans Affairs Main Office at 800 Vermont. I worked in the Directors office for about 5 years then I moved to Technical Support Division, where I became a System Programmer for Mainframes. I did that job for a while and then, we migrated the entire Data Processing Center to Networks and I became one of the Network Administrator after they sent me to some of the schools for network administration (we had many network administrators). I retired from the Dept of Veterans Affairs in 1996.

I am married to my second wife now for 34 years, Viola G, Brown. I have three boys by my first wife who is now deceased, and my current wife had a set of twin daughters when we got married in 1985. All of my Children are in their 40's. I have three children in the Austin area, one in Dallas area, and one in Huntington Beach, Ca.

When I retired in 1996, I went to work for the Pct # 3 Constable's Office in Travis County (Austin, Texas). Previously, I had been a Reserve Deputy Sheriff for Travis County from 1974 until 1996 because I enjoyed law enforcement, but knew I could not make a living working in the law enforcement field at the time. I resigned as a Reserve Deputy to go to work as full time as a Deputy Constable. I worked there from 1996 until 2004. I left there in 2004, and went back to the Travis County Sheriffs' Dept. as a



Full time Deputy Sheriff and worked there from 2004 until 2006 and retired so that I could be vested with the County and District Retirement System of Texas.

We sold our home in Austin in 2006 and started traveling in our 5th wheel, because I always wanted to see as much of the Lower 48 states as I could. We were able to accomplish that in 3 1/2 years, and then we settled up here in Meadowlakes in Dec. 2009, which is where my parents are living. We have been to Alaska and Hawaii, but not in the 5th wheel. I have been your City Councilman for the last two years and I am seeking your vote for another term for City Council Place 5.
