
CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play that every candidate and political committee in this state has a moral obligation to observe and uphold, in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, our citizens may exercise their constitutional rights to a free and untrammelled choice and the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

THEREFORE:

- (1) I will conduct the campaign openly and publicly and limit attacks on my opponent to legitimate challenges to my opponent's record and stated positions on issues.
- (2) I will not use or permit the use of character defamation, whispering campaigns, libel, slander, or scurrilous attacks on any candidate or the candidate's personal or family life.
- (3) I will not use or permit any appeal to negative prejudice based on race, sex, religion, or national origin.
- (4) I will not use campaign material of any sort that misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise falsifies the facts, nor will I use malicious or unfounded accusations that aim at creating or exploiting doubts, without justification, as to the personal integrity or patriotism of my opponent.
- (5) I will not undertake or condone any dishonest or unethical practice that tends to corrupt or undermine our system of free elections or that hampers or prevents the full and free expression of the will of the voters, including any activity aimed at intimidating voters or discouraging them from voting.
- (6) I will defend and uphold the right of every qualified voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process, and will not engage in any activity aimed at intimidating voters or discouraging them from voting.
- (7) I will immediately and publicly repudiate methods and tactics that may come from others that I have pledged not to use or condone. I shall take firm action against any subordinate who violates any provision of this code or the laws governing elections.

I, the undersigned, candidate for election to public office in the State of Texas or campaign treasurer of a political committee, hereby voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct the campaign in accordance with the above principles and practices.

Kirk D. Noaker, Sr.

My name is Kirk Noaker and I live at 202 Firestone Drive with my wife Jessica Noaker and our six year old son. I suspect you're familiar with my house without having to look it up on a map as it's the very first house on your right as you pass through the Meadowlakes gate.

I'm the Burnet County Magistrate Judge and Associate Municipal Judge for the cities of Burnet and Bertram by day and I am a community advocate by night. I'm proud to serve on the Board of Directors for the Highland Lakes CASA. I'm also the Vice President of the Parent Teacher Fellowship (PTF) at First Baptist Christian School. In 2013, I was honored as the Marble Falls Chamber of Commerce's Volunteer of the Year. In my free time, I volunteer for many organizations that help build the community such as: Hill Country Children's Advocacy Center, Marble Falls Chamber of Commerce, and Marble Falls Daybreak Rotary as I am a former member who still volunteers for various Rotary projects. Lastly, I'm serving as a Director of the Highland Lakes Squadron's Bluebonnet Airsho 2019 event.

As a full time Burnet County Magistrate, I am charged with findings of probable cause, setting bonds, issuing arrest warrants, and many other statutory requirements as they relate to the arrest and charging of a defendant. Along with magistrate duties, I am attentive to mental health, substance abuse, family abuse, and other needs of the defendant. It is my belief that services such as these will bring help to a person who might have given up all hope. I don't believe that our neighbors around us, people who we grocery shop with, nor people who we share the roads with should be in position where they feel that they have no hope. I think we all recognize that our nation faces a mental health and substance abuse crisis. Substance abuse tears down lives, breaks apart families, and can debilitate a community. As I execute the judicial responsibilities of a magistrate, I understand I'm in the unique position of being able to order substance abuse treatment, mental health services, or any other type of reasonable & positive influence for the defendant. This is important to not only make them a more reliable defendant as their case is adjudicated, but it helps to better their own lives. We live in a very generous community here in the Highland Lakes and have access to many non-profit organizations. I feel it is my responsibility to connect those in need of services with any one of these valuable resources.

I was born and raised in Michigan and I served in the United States Army Military Police Corps for 6 years in the late 80's and early 90's. I was a police officer for the Baltimore Police Department and Sheriff's Deputy for Washington County Sheriff's Office in the State of Maryland. While I was assigned to the Drug Enforcement Administration's Narcotics Task Force in the Baltimore-Washington area, our nation was attacked on 9-11. Our President at the time explained that we needed more Federal Air Marshals to shore up our security weaknesses in commercial aviation. I answered his call and applied and was hired as a Federal Air Marshal operating out of the Washington Field Office. I was diligently trained in counter terrorism tactics and strategy and was committed to doing whatever was necessary to combat terrorism. In the early 2000's, I was selected to serve in the FBI's JTTF (Joint Terrorism Task Force) where I was a point-man for all things terror-related in the transportation sector in western Maryland.

After federal service, I worked in the private sector before accepting a position with the State of Texas, Regional Public Defender's Office, AKA: RPDO. The RPDO is charged with representing indigent defendants who are charged with capital crimes where the death penalty is pursued. After operating for years on the prosecutorial side of things, this role was indeed challenging, yet, incredibly transformational and informative. The 5 years I served with the RPDO, coupled with the accumulation of my years of life, enhanced my ability to see that there is more to just a black and white scenario. In fact, there are several shades of gray. My eyes were opened to the PEOPLE who are involved in these cases. My passion for the judicial system grew beyond the limits of my old cop mindset, and I am consistently amazed to learn something new every day in my current profession as a Magistrate Judge.

As I reminisce on my previous professions, I am reminded of my life's travels and the places I once called home. I am then reminded of the day that I traveled north on Hwy 281 from the San Antonio area to come to the Highland Lakes, as a promising career sought to bring me here. I sat next to the love of my life as we came over a hill, and our eyes became fixated on the beauty of the little town on Lake Marble Falls. Our fascination and love of the Highland Lakes has never lost an ounce of appreciation of that view ever since.

I promise you that I can and I will serve the residents of the City of Meadowlakes in an ethical, reasonable, and responsible manner. I will serve as a person committed to high standards for this community and the preservation of our treasured quality of life.
