

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-01**

**Date: January 11, 2011**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MEADOWLAKES, BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS, TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 7, 2006, PROVIDING FOR AN UPDATE OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES FOR RESIDENTIAL RATES IN THE MANNER SET FORTH BELOW.**

*Whereas, the City Council on December 4, 2007 entered into a contract with BFI Waste Services of Texas, LP d/b/a Allied Waste Services of Marble Falls, for collection of solid waste within the City, which provides for incremental increases in residential solid waste collection fees per year to off-set the providers increasing expenses; and,*

*Whereas, the City Council of the City of Meadowlakes on January 10, 2008 adopted the second reading of Ordinance 2007-18 which established water, sanitary sewer and solid waste collection rates, fees, charges and late payment penalties; and,*

*Whereas, the City Council on August 12, 2008 adopted Ordinance Number 2008-19 to include such sanitary rates and solid waste collection fees, charges and late payment penalties language to be codified into the City's Code of Ordinances; and,*

*Whereas, the City Council on December 8, 2008 adopted Ordinance Number 2008-31 amending the City's Code of Ordinances to reflect solid waste rates and fees for calendar years 2009 and 2010; and,*

*Whereas, the City Council finds and determines that it is necessary and proper to amend the City's current solid waste rates and fees to include the yearly adjustments per the terms and conditions as expressed in the Contract with BFI Waste Services of Texas, LP.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEADOWLAKES, BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The above and foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein as findings of fact.

**Section 2.** The City of Meadowlakes Code of Ordinances Section §A50, subsection (C) Solid Waste Collection Fees for Residential Rates shall be amended as referenced in attached Exhibit "A."

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

**Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in force when the provisions of this Ordinance becomes effective which are inconsistent or in conflict with the terms, conditions and provisions in this Ordinance are hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** Should any part, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance be determined to be unlawful, void or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be adversely affected.

**Section 6.** The meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

**EXHIBIT "A"**

1.) Amend Section §A50 PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FEES, Subsection (C) Solid Waste Collection Fees for Residential Rates by removing the text that has a strike through and replacing and/or adding text that is in ***bold, italics print***.

(C) Solid Waste Collection Fees:

The following monthly rates and charges are hereby established for solid waste collection provided by the City, to-wit:

Residential Rates:

Customer inside City:

A flat rate of ~~\$18.20~~ ***\$19.30*** per month shall be charged to all occupied homes of residential customers effective ~~January 1, 2009~~ ***January 1, 2011***.

A flat rate of ~~\$18.70~~ ***\$19.90*** per month shall be charged to all occupied homes of residential customers effective ~~January 1, 2010~~ ***January 1, 2012***.

***A flat rate of \$20.55 per month shall be charged to all occupied homes of residential customers effective January 1, 2013.***

***A flat rate of \$21.20 per month shall be charged to all occupied homes of residential customers effective January 1, 2014.***
